Description:

Teaching position at the Upper Valley Music Center (UVMC), a non-profit community music school dedicated to the study, performance, and enjoyment of music by participants of all ages and levels of experience. UVMC offers year round instruction in a wide range of instruments as well as orchestra, chorus, ensembles, school based programs, traditional folk music and other group programs. UVMC has a young and growing piano program, and there is an opportunity to help shape that growth.

Duties:

Teaching: Teach piano lessons to students of all ages and beginning, intermediate and advanced levels. Teach a range of styles and repertoire. Potential to start a Suzuki Piano program for a qualified candidate. (Approximately .75 of position)

Collaborative Piano: Accompany group classes, solo instrumentalists and singers in lessons and performances (levels ranging from beginning to advanced). Coach students individually. Coach chamber music. Perform in faculty concerts. (Approximately .25 of position)

Close collaboration with other faculty and parents in developing UVMC programs expected.

Qualifications

Music degree required. Candidate must be committed to excellence in teaching, with well-developed nurturing and communication skills. Teamwork and willingness to help develop UVMC programming essential.

Salary

Full time salaried position during school year with year-round benefits. Competitive hourly rate over the summer.
