HOW TO PARTICIPATE

There are two main ways to participate: **Making Music** and **Fundraising**. You can choose to do one or both—either way, we encourage you to sign up in advance!

MAKING MUSIC

There are many ways to make music on May 19!

You can sign up for a **Solo & Small Group** recital. All genres of music are welcome. You can also join the **pickup orchestra, chorus, or band**, a jazz or traditional music **jam**, or a **Music Together** sing-and-dance-along!

Throughout the day there will be concerts by **Juneberry Chorus**, the **Upper Valley Chamber Orchestra**, **Vivace Orchestra**, the **Cello Ensemble** and the **Suzuki** and **Voice** programs.

Currently enrolled UVMC students pay no fee to participate! Check out the full schedule and description of options attached to this letter.

The goal of Sing & Play 50k is to highlight the breadth of and enthusiasm for music making in our community—so, the more the merrier! You don't have to be enrolled at UVMC to participate. Invite your musical friends to join. Out of town that day? You can record your performance in advance or live-stream a video if you want to be part of it. And just to reiterate—*you don't have to fundraise to make music.*

FUNDRAISING

UVMC's new home at 8 South Park Street has already made an impact, but we haven't yet completed the campaign to fund the building. To date the Securing Our Future campaign has raised \$760,000 of our \$940,000 goal.

If you want to help provide a home for music education now and for generations to come, sign up to **tell your story about why music matters.**

Think of it as a musical marathon—you can ask friends, family, and neighbors to sponsor your performance for a nickel per second, a dime per second, a quarter per second, or any amount!

Setting up a personal donation page is easy. You can also sign up as a family or team (e. g. string quartet, alto section) for a team challenge! **If we raise \$20,000 by April 30, we will receive a \$10,000 challenge gift from Tom & Judy Csatari.** There are also fun rewards for your fundraising success (in addition to the good cause).

The goal for Sing & Play 50k is to reach 1,000 total donors and raise \$40,000 through participant fundraising. *If every student got just 3 donations of \$35 each, we would exceed this goal!*

GETTING STARTED

Visit www.uvmusic.org/sp50k for a schedule, links to sign up to make music, and to create a personal donation page. Sign up early — we expect performance slots to fill, and **everyone who creates a personal donation page before April 6 gets an SP50k car magnet or shaker egg!**

VOLUNTEERING

Like any good fundraising event, we'll need lots of help on the big day! Help us welcome guests, organize performers, set up and clean up. Sign up and pick a time slot online.

Music Making Options

Solos & Small Groups - Sign up for a solo or round up a few friends for a small group performance. All genres of music welcome (yes, we mean all genres). Piano, music stands, and chairs provided. You must supply any additional equipment needed. Intimate venue. Location: UVMC; Time: 12 - 6 pm

Music Together (Toddlers and parents) - Sing and dance like you are three years old. Correction: with your three-year-old. Our experienced Music Together faculty lead sessions for 0-5 year olds and their parents. Location: Colburn Park; Time: 9 - 10 am or 10 - 11 am

Pickup Chorus - Come sing with friends and neighbors conducted by Jane Woods. All voice parts welcome. Sheet music provided and a few songs taught by ear. No preparation required. Location: Lebanon First Congregational Church; Time: 9:30 - 10:30

Pickup Orchestra - Come sight read with fellow musicians and conductor Mark Nelson. All orchestral instruments welcome. Experience reading music will be helpful. No preparation required. Bring a music stand and your instrument. Location: Lebanon First Congregational Church; Time: 11 am - 12 pm

Pickup Band - Gather in Colburn Park to sight read band favorites with friends and conductor Mark Nelson. All wind, brass and percussion band instruments welcome. Experience reading music will be helpful. No preparation required. Bring a music stand and your instrument. Location: Colburn Park; Time: 12 - 1 pm

Jazz Jam - Bring your favorite jazz standards and jam. Lead by UVMC Faculty Michael Zsoldos. Location: UVMC; Time: 1:30 - 2:30 pm

Pub Jam - Play traditional fiddle tunes lead by fiddler George Fowler. All instruments welcome. Location: Salt Hill; Time: 7 - 9 pm

Suzuki Alumni Play In – A play in for anyone who grew up studying in a Suzuki Program. All instruments welcome. Lead by UVMC's Suzuki faculty, we'll play all of your favorites, including, of course, Twinkle Twinkle Little Star. Location: Colburn Park; Time 1:30 – 2:30 pm

On the Town - We bring music to Sing & Play 50k sponsors. A musical adventure for all involved.

UVMC Ensemble Concerts - Concerts featuring Upper Valley Chamber Orchestra, Juneberry Chorus, Vivace Orchestra, the Cello Ensemble, the Suzuki Program, the Voice Studio and more will take place throughout the day. Official Audience members welcome.

Official Audience Member - Performers need people to share their music with. You'll receive an 'I Applaud!' button and be responsible for showering performers with enthusiastic applause. Parents of children participating are automatically Official Audience Members :)
