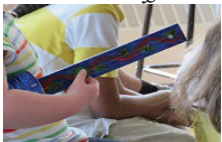

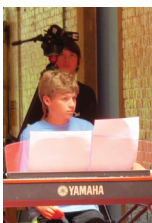
Music Video
