## **Suzuki Violin/Viola Teaching Fellowship Position**

**Summary:** 2 year full-time teaching position with structured mentor support

**About Upper Valley Music Center:** The Upper Valley Music Center (UVMC) is a non-profit community music school with programs for children and adults. The Suzuki Program includes more than 120 students in cello, viola, and violin and six faculty members who work in close collaboration. In addition to the Suzuki program, UVMC offers year round instruction in a wide range of instruments as well as orchestra, chorus, ensembles, traditional folk music and other group programs. UVMC faculty perform in the community and the broader New England region.

**Description:** The Suzuki Violin/Viola Fellowship is a full-time teaching position designed for teachers who have completed book training (minimum Violin or Viola Books 1 - 4) and would like to work as part of a team and receive additional support and mentorship during two years of teaching.

Duties include teaching individual lessons and team teaching group classes. Support is provided through weekly mentorship meetings with the Suzuki Program Coordinator and the opportunity to observe and collaborate with other teachers.

The Fellowship is a two year position. Potential to continue as a full-time faculty member after the 2 year fellowship. Full job description available upon request.

**Qualifications:** Music degree and SAA registration in Violin or Viola Books 1-4 required. Registration in Books 5 and above highly desirable. Candidate must be committed to Suzuki philosophy, with well developed nurturing and communication skills. Chamber music performance and coaching experience desirable. Teamwork, good communication skills, and willingness to help develop UVMC programming essential.

**Compensation:** Full-time salaried position during school year. Competitive hourly rate over the summer. Year round health stipend. Salary and rate ranges available on request.

**Location:** Lebanon, NH; is part of the growing Upper Connecticut River Valley that includes Dartmouth College, a major regional medical center, technology businesses and a thriving arts community. Lebanon is 1 hour from Concord, NH, 1.25 hours from Burlington VT, 2 hours from Boston and 2.5 hours from Hartford CT.
